Admission Policy for Schools

Booking Criteria: It is mandatiory to book a school visit in advance. Visit date and a time will only be confirmed upon the payment of a booking fee of Rs. 15,000. Furthermore, **100% advance** payment is required **7 days prior** to the visit.

Duration of Visit: The standard duration of the visit will be 4 hours, including a short briefing in the beginning, meals served at the cafe, and a session in the auditorium.

Feedback: The MSC sees visitor input and feedback as help to constantly improve but also a form of communication. We expect that a representative of a school fills out the feedback form in return we grant one teacher for every 50 students free of charge.

Teacher Supervision: Students must be supervised in all the exhibition areas. We recommend a ratio of one teacher for every 15 students. **For every 30 students, 1 visitor (ticket) will be given complimentary.**

Guidelines

- 1. Science communicators will be available at designated areas of MSC. Teachers are requested to guide their students and connect the content demonstrated through the exhibits with their teaching/curriculum.
- 2. Heavy luggage/bags are not allowed inside MSC. Storing school bags will only consume your time.
- 3. It is strongly advised that children in Grades 3 and under do not use the tree house in the Science Garden for their own safety and well-being.
- 4. General visitors will also be allowed inside the exhibition areas during school visits.
- 5. Food can only be ordered for the entire group. Outside food and drinks are not allowed inside the premises.
- 6. MSC's Foodology Café cannot cater to orders for big groups (over 10 visitors), therefore, we urge you to pre-order meals in case you are bringing a large group.
- 7. We may divide your school group into smaller units therefore teachers are required to supervise all the groups throughout the visit.
- 8. Ground floor exhibits are open to students of pre-primary level till class 6. The exhibits on the second floor, primarily related to mathematics and physics, are more relevant to students of class 7 and above.
- 9. Any variation from the original booking should be agreed upon in writing with the MSC management.
- 10. MSC promotes diversity and encourages mutual respect for everyone.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Booking is only valid for the date requested.
- 2. We take full advance payment 7 days prior to the visit.
- 3. We take booking amount of Rs. 15,000/- at the time of blocking the date.
- 4. The booking amount and advance amount is non-refundable, non-exchangeable, and non-transferable.
- 5. In case of any damage caused to an exhibit by a visitor, its equal market value, as per TDF's evaluation, will be levied.
- 6. In case of cancellation due to any unforeseen situation, MSC should be notified at least 24 hours in advance, upon which the booking date can be rescheduled.
- 7. Professional cameras are not allowed inside the premises.
- 8. Entry is free for children 2 years and below.
- 9. MSC will not be responsible for any loss, damage, disease, or injury caused to any visitor during their visit.



- 10. MSC will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any personal belongings left unattended at the premises. Any unattended item found will be deposited in the lost and found area on the ground floor.
- 11. Eating and/or drinking is not permitted in the exhibition areas; it is only allowed inside the Foodology Cafe.
- 12. Smoking is only allowed at the designated smoking areas.

Services:

- 1. Professional photographer covering the visit/event on demand will charge Rs. 7,000/-. We will share minimum 100 high resolution pictures with basic colour correction on google drive within 48 hours.
- 2. Screening of documentary films (subject to availability of the auditorium).
- 3. Valet parking.
- 4. In-house café has a maximum capacity of 70 persons.
